

## OSSLT 2019

The OSSLT (Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test) will be taking place on Wednesday, March 27th. The OSSLT is a standardized EQAO test that all grade 10 students in Ontario will be writing. Successful completion of the test is a graduation requirement, and students must attend. A score of 75% is required to pass the OSSLT, and students are permitted to access *assessment accommodations* as outlined in their IEPs.

Every Wednesday, from now until the test, students will be participating in preparatory sessions. Activities will be posted on our OSSLT Google Classroom, so that students who miss one or more of the sessions will still have access to the content. We encourage parents to subscribe to our Google Classroom as well, in order to receive updates.
